Students will be prompted to log in using your **Middlesex University user ID** (e.g. AB123) and **Password** (e.g. London42) OR you can use your **Borrower ID** (student number) e.g. M01234567 and **Date of Birth** e.g. 010290.

Staff should use their **Middlesex University IT User ID** (e.g. Jeff82) and **Password** (e.g. London42).

A Request Confirmation box will appear. Make sure you have selected the correct pick-up location as you are able to pick up the requested item from any of the campus libraries, and then click on Request.
