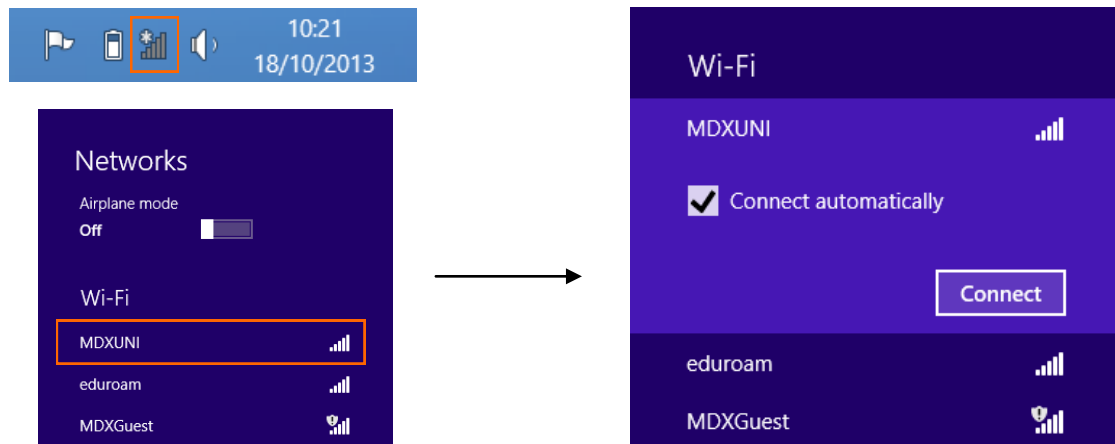


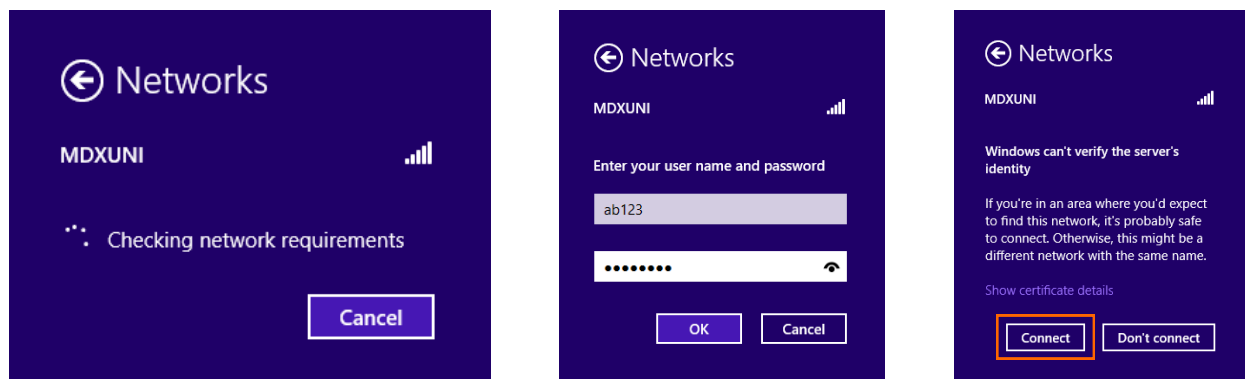
Wireless network guide

Windows 8

Step 1: Click on the wireless icon in your taskbar; it should indicate that wireless connections are available. A list of wireless networks will pop up in a column on the right of your desktop—select the **MDXUNI** network.



Step 2: Make sure the **Connect Automatically** box has been ticked, and then click on the **Connect** button. Your computer will then attempt to connect to the **MDXUNI** network.



Step 3: After a few seconds you will be asked for your **user name and password**. Please ensure you enter your PC network login ID (e.g. ab123) and password details correctly, then click on **OK**.

You will see a **Windows can't verify the server's identity** message as shown in the screenshot on the right above; you can choose to click on **Show certificate details** to check that the certificate originated from a valid university server—either **whep-acsa01.uni.mdx.ac.uk** or **mdx-nwa-dc1.uni.mdx.ac.uk**.

After verifying, please ensure you click on the **Connect** button to confirm network connection.

Step 4: After a few seconds, the Networks column on the right of your desktop will show that you are connected to MDXUNI, and the wireless icon on the taskbar will also indicate a successful connection to the wireless network.

You will now have access to the internet on campus, as well as all university resources.
