


## Downloading NVivo20 on your personal Mac device

What is **NVivo**? It is a qualitative data analysis (QDA) computer software package. NVivo is used to assist qualitative researchers by analysing and organising unstructured qualitative data such as surveys, interviews, articles, web content, and social media data, where deep levels of data analysis are required.

Go to '<https://kbox.mdx.ac.uk>'. Log in with your **student User ID** e.g. AB123 and password. Do not try to log in with your University email address
